
HELP US ACHIEVE


HOW DO YOU PARTICIPATE?

GENERAL

• All Monte Vista Primary stalls are completely cashless on the day. We accept card payments.

- There will be one entry point where the entry bands will be sold for R20. We shall be selling entry bands beforehand (cash), obtainable from the class educator. Entry bands bought on the day will be using card facilities. Pre-sales end on Friday, 11 April 2025 at 07:45. Ticket sales for the games stations are only done on the day on a card basis.
- Learners who collect R150 on their sponsorship form will receive a free entry band. Gr R Collect your pre-bought bands at the gate on Kaskar Day. Gr 1 3 Will be put in flip-file and sent home on Friday 11 April 2025. Gr 4 7 Will be sent home in an envelope with your child on Friday 11 April 2025. Children of 5 years and younger = free entry.
- Ticket-to-win-it is available from the child's educator. This is a lucky draw of 10 boxes (one for each letter in MONTE VISTA). Each R100 booklet consists of 10 tickets of R10 each. Sell the tickets to friends and family and return the stubs and money to the class educator. The draw for this competition will take place on 12 April 2025 at 15:00 in the arena. There are ten hampers that are up for grabs. There will also be lucky draws throughout the day, and ticket-to-win-it may be bought at the arena on the day with card facilities only. Lucky winners will need to produce their ticket to claim a prize. Parents who organised sponsored prizes automatically contribute to their class' unlocked reward tier.
- Try to limit the use of cash on the day.
- In the event of rain, the day will continue.
- Alcohol on premises is prohibited.
- We have been granted permission to park on the municipal field opposite the school. Please obey the traffic marshals and mind the irrigation systems on the field. Law enforcement will issue fines for illegal parking.
